

Start of Walk Introduction Points (last updated Nov 2024)

- Introduce yourself and the name of the walk.
- Welcome everyone. Let anyone new to Ramblers know they can talk to you if they want more information about the Group.
- Give the distance, pace and terrain of the walk and highlight any potential walk hazards such as blind bends, busy roads, rickety stiles etc. Give estimated time of lunch and end time of the walk.
- Mention any toilet stops.
- Mention potential dropout points if there are any.
- Describe lunch details i.e. pub and / or picnic. Get numbers of those wanting pub lunch as pre-booking may be recommended.
- Ask for a back marker with a mobile phone. Give them a route map, If available, and ask them to help count up numbers.
- Ask walkers to let you or back marker know if they are having any problems or intend to drop out.
- Warn that photos may be posted to Social Media and anyone not wanting to appear should speak out.
- Ask if there any questions. Set off!
